

## MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING

### SHENANDOAH CITY COUNCIL

The meeting was called to order by Mayor M. Ritchey Wheeler at 7:00 p.m. City Council members present, Councilmember McLeod, Councilmember Bradt, Councilmember Fletcher and Councilmember Raymaker. City Administrator Kathie Reyer, City Secretary Courtney Clary, City Attorney William Ferebee, IT Manager Chris Grizzaffi, and Communications Manager Debbie Pilcher were also present.

1. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Wheeler called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Mayor Wheeler stated for the record that Councilmember Escoto was absent and excused from the meeting.

AN ORDINANCE CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION HELD ON MAY 7, 2022, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING A MAYOR AND TWO (2) CITY COUNCIL MEMBERS, POSITIONS 1 AND 5, TO THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF SHENANDOAH, TEXAS.

COUNCILMEMBER FLETCHER MADE A MOTION TO ADOPT AN ORDINANCE CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION HELD ON MAY 7, 2022, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING A MAYOR AND TWO (2) CITY COUNCIL MEMBERS, POSITIONS 1 AND 5, TO THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF SHENANDOAH, TEXAS, COUNCILMEMBER BRADT SECONDED. THE MOTION CARRIED 4/0.


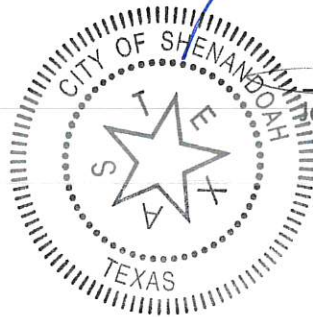

Any discussion item on the City Council agenda permits City Council to question the involved parties or receive a presentation by the involved parties.
