

ORDINANCE NO. O-14-033

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SHENANDOAH, TEXAS REGULATING THE PARKING OF NON-PASSENGER VEHICLES ON CITY STREETS; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$500 FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF; PROVIDING SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS there are a number of recreational vehicles, trailers and other non passenger vehicles that park on city streets; and

WHEREAS these non passenger vehicles are both unsightly and cause hazardous traffic conditions; and


WHEREAS the City Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the residents of the City of Shenandoah and promotes the health and safety of the community to regulate the times that these types of vehicles are permitted to park on public streets;

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHENANDOAH THAT THE FOLLOWING PARKING REGULATIONS ARE ENACTED:

1. Vehicles exceeding two axles or that are greater than twenty six feet in length (bumper to bumper) or greater than ten feet in height from ground to highest portion of the vehicle body are not be permitted to park on public streets between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.
2. Trailers, recreational vehicles, boats, jet skis, golf carts, tractors and all terrain vehicles are not be permitted to park on public streets between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.
3. The owner of any trailer, recreational vehicle, boat, Jet Ski, golf cart, tractor or all terrain vehicle shall not permit it to be parked on a public street between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.
4. A violation of this Ordinance may is punishable by a fine of up to \$500.00.
5. Each twenty four hour period constitutes a separate violation.
